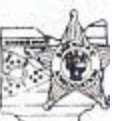

*Community Anti-Terrorism Training Institute (CAT Eyes)*

*Thank you for the comments concerning our efforts to instruct the citizens of Summit County concerning anti-terrorism through the CAT Eyes Program. As I recently stated, "while law enforcement is central to public safety and homeland security, one thing is certain: law enforcement and government need the help of residents to build long-lasting, safer communities." Since its inception in the year 2002:*

- over 50 classes have been conducted on "CAT Eyes;"*
- the message has reached over 4,000 actual people within a classroom setting;*
- "CAT Eyes" was videotaped and shown a total of 12 times on a local cable station to approximately 300,000 people in the county;*
- the "CAT Eyes" class was taught at two universities; Bowling Green State University, Kent State University, to federal prosecutors and attorneys involved in the Joint Terrorism Task Force.*

*Along with city and township councils, the Home Owners Association invited Lieutenant Gary James to present the program early this spring in order to facilitate situational awareness at the neighborhood level.*
